## ARKANSAS STATE USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament.
2. All bowlers entering the Arkansas State Open Championship Tournament must be a member of a USBC Association in the State of Arkansas. Membership cards must be shown at check-in.
3. Lanes will be dressed after each squad as needed.
4. All awards will be based on handicap other than the optional scratch all-events. There will be at least one prize awarded for each 8 entries in the team, doubles and singles events and at least one prize awarded for each 20 paid entries in the handicap and scratch all-events.
5. Averages to be used in the tournament and in order of their use are: Highest 2012-2013 winter yearbook average, Highest 2013 summer average, or highest current average. Bowlers that do not have a qualifying average may enter using a 220 average. All averages must be based on 21 or more games. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their average (USBC Rule 319a3). Youth and Collegiate averages are not permitted for this tournament. Individuals must indicate if an average is a "sports league average". USBC Rule 203 shall apply. Individual's highest average will be used, regular or adjusted sport league as appropriate.
6. Rule 319c shall apply in reporting averages. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify their entering average even though submitted by someone other than themselves by initialing the official score sheet at the time they are scheduled to bowl. Failure to use the proper average or to make the necessary corrections shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average. If submitted average is higher than the actual average, the prize winnings will be based on the higher submitted average.
7. Handicap shall be based on team concept for team and doubles events, and individual concept for singles and all-events. Base average shall be 1100 (Team) and 440 (Doubles) and 220 for singles and all-events. Handicap shall be 90% of the difference. **USBC RULE 319A2 (TEN PIN RULE) SHALL APPLY.**
8. Substitutions will be allowed but must bowl in the same position as the bowler being substituted. All substitutions must be reported to the Tournament Manager no later than 45 minutes prior to scheduled time to bowl, with the proper verification of substitute's average. Team Captains or his representative shall sign all requests for substitutions.
9. **ENTRIES CLOSE ON APRIL 13, 2014.**
10. Bowlers will be permitted to bowl twice in the team event and minor event (Doubles & Singles) subject to USBC Rules 315b and 315c. A bowler entering the minor events must enter both. If a team enters the tournament a second time, they must replace at least two bowlers on the original entry in order to cash a second time. If a doubles team enters a second time, they must replace at least one bowler on the original entry in order to cash a second time.
11. Entries not verified by legible signature of Association or League Secretary will be indicated as not verified on confirmation letter. Bowlers without certified averages will be considered a 220 bowler and receive no handicap.
12. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled when authorized by the tournament manager.
13. **DRESS CODE; No muscle shirts, short shorts, tank tops or spandex. No writing or figures on clothing that are deemed offensive by the tournament manager will be allowed.**
